# ICCON TRANSMISSION INC. ("ICCON") RESPONSES TO INTERROGATORIES

March 22, 2011

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## **BOARD STAFF INTERROGATORY 1**

## **QUESTION**

In section D of its licence application, Iccon confirmed the following:

"I understand and acknowledge that, as a licenced electricity transmitter, I will be required, unless otherwise exempted:

- To provide non-discriminatory access to all persons wishing to connect to the transmission system.
- To comply with all licence conditions including the provisions of:
  - The Ontario Energy Board Affiliate Relationships Code for Electricity Distributors and Transmitters
  - o The Ontario Energy Board Transmission System Code
  - o The Market Rules made under section 32 of the Electricity Act."

Absent an exemption, Iccon must comply with the Board's Affiliate Relationships Code for Electricity Distributors and Transmitters ("ARC") (among others) effective as of the date on which a transmission licence is issued to it. Please confirm that Iccon will satisfy the requirements of the ARC commencing on the date on which it is licensed. If not, please advise if Iccon intends to seek an exemption from the ARC.

### **RESPONSE**

Iccon will comply with the requirements of the ARC as of the date it is licenced and does not intend to seek an exemption from any provisions of the ARC. If in the future Iccon foresees being unable to comply with any provision the ARC, it will apply to the Board for an exemption at that time.

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#### **BOARD STAFF INTERROGATORY 2**

#### **QUESTION**

Iccon's application indicates that Iccon will rely on the personnel of Isolux Ingenieria S.A., an affiliate, for the design and construction of the transmission facilities. Will the same technical resources be employed to address technical matters related to the operation and maintenance of the transmission facilities? If not, please describe Iccon's plans.

## **RESPONSE**

As noted in its application, Isolux is seeking a licence to participate in the Board's Transmission Project Development designation process. At this time Iccon has not determined the specific technical resources that it will rely upon to address matters related to the operation and maintenance of any future transmission facilities in Ontario. Iccon expects to carry out the operation and maintenance of any such facilities through a combination of internal and external resources. This is an arrangement Isolux Corsan companies have employed in other jurisdictions and, as is demonstrated in the Iccon's licence application, Isolux Corsan companies have a proven track record of owning and operating major transmission projects and have substantial resources and expertise available to them to meet these obligations.

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## **BOARD STAFF INTERROGATORY 3**

#### **QUESTION**

Iccon has provided the financial statements of Isolux Corsan Concesiones, S.A.U. in support of its financial capability as Iccon is a newly formed entity for which financial statements have not yet been prepared. In these circumstances, the Board may require a parental guarantee. Please confirm that Iccon has reviewed the Board's standard parental guarantee form and would be prepared to have Isolux Corsan Concesiones, S.A.U. provide financial assurance for the Board's costs under the electricity transmission licence should the Board consider such assurance necessary.

### **RESPONSE**

Iccon has reviewed the Board's standard parental guarantee form for electricity transmitters. If the Board requires, Isolux Corsan Concesiones, S.A.U. would be prepared to provide a parental guarantee, explicitly limited as Board staff indicates to, providing financial assurance of the Board's costs under the transmission licence. It is Iccon's position that if the Board were to require a parental guarantee, it would not be required after Iccon has commenced viable commercial operations in Ontario as a transmission owner and operator.
