NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND WRITTEN HEARING

Application by Orangeville Hydro Limited for an Exemption from their Mandated Time-of-Use Pricing Date

The Application

Orangeville Hydro Limited ("Orangeville Hydro") filed an application dated March 15, 2011 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B) for a licence amendment granting an exemption in relation to the mandated date for the implementation of Time-of-Use ("TOU") pricing rates for Regulated Price Plan ("RPP") consumers.

Time-of-Use Pricing

On August 4, 2010 the Ontario Energy Board issued a determination under Section 1.2.1 of the Standard Supply Service Code to require the implementation of TOU pricing for Regulated Price Plan consumers. The determination established mandatory TOU implementation dates for each electricity distributor. Orangeville Hydro is applying for an exemption from its June 2011 mandatory TOU date and requesting a new mandatory TOU date of September 2011. Orangeville Hydro states the reason for the exemption is due to delays experienced implementing and coordinating the roll-out and training on a new customer information system and advanced metering infrastructure network, which has caused Orangeville Hydro to fall behind on original wave testing dates with the Independent Electricity System Operator.

How to Participate in the Hearing

The application will be decided by way of written hearing unless a party satisfies the Board that there is good reason for not holding a written hearing. If you object to a written hearing for this application, you must provide written reasons why an oral hearing is necessary. Any submissions objecting to a written hearing must be received by the Board and copied to the applicant by **April 11, 2011**.

Any parties who wish information and material from the applicant that is in addition to the applicant's pre-filed evidence with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to the applicant on or before **April 14, 2011**. Where possible, the questions should specifically reference the pre-filed evidence. The applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to any interested parties in the proceeding no later than **April 25, 2011**.

Anyone who wishes to make a submission on the application must file that written submission with the Board and deliver it to the applicant by **May 2, 2011**. If the applicant wishes to respond to the submission(s), the written response must be filed with the Board and delivered to all parties who made submissions by **May 9, 2011**. All written submissions sent to the Board will be placed on the public record. The written submissions will be available for viewing at the Board's offices and will be placed on the Board's website.

If the written submission is from a private citizen (i.e., not a lawyer representing a client, not a consultant representing a client or organization, not an individual in an organization that represents the interests of consumers or other groups, and not an individual from a regulated entity), before placing the written submission on the public record, the Board will remove any personal (i.e., not business) contact information from the written submission (i.e., the address, fax number, phone number, and e-mail address of the individual). However, the name of the individual and the content of the written submission will become part of the public record.

You must forward two paper copies, and if possible, an electronic copy in Word format and searchable PDF format, of your written submission to the Board and one copy to the applicant. All submissions must quote file number EB-2011-0082 and clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.
