IN THE MATTER OF an Application by Hydro One Networks Inc. pursuant to Section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 for approval for changes to electricity distribution rates effective May 1, 2008.

REQUEST FOR INTERVENOR STATUS OF UNION GAS LIMITED

- 1. Union Gas Limited ("Union") hereby applies for intervenor status in this proceeding pursuant to the above-captioned matter.
- 2. Union is an Ontario Corporation with its Registered Office at the Municipality of Chatham-Kent, in the Province of Ontario. Union is a regulated public utility, which combines the operations of selling, distributing, transmitting and storing gas within the meaning of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998.
- 3. Union is a significant customer of Hydro One Networks Inc. and as such, has an interest in all aspects of the proceeding.
- 4. Union has a direct interest in all matters of jurisdiction, substance and procedure in the regulation of public utilities, and in any decision of the Board, which may create a precedent affecting Union's operations and/or rates.
- 5. Union requests one copy of the evidence and submissions of the Applicant and other Intervenors, and any notices or correspondence. This includes any revisions or amendments, which may be made prior to the commencement of, or during the hearing of the Applications. Union's preference would be to receive one paper and one searchable electronic version of the original prefiled evidence and then searchable electronic versions of any filings after that.

- 6. At this time, it is Union's intention to monitor the proceeding; however, after reviewing the evidence, Union may wish to address one or more of the issues. Union does not have a preference for an oral or written proceeding.
- 7. Union reserves the right to adduce evidence, cross-examine witnesses, advance argument and participate in the proceeding as circumstances may require.
