Re: EB-2011-0090 - Motion by Ontario Power Generation Inc. Pursuant to Rule 42 of the Ontario Energy Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure

EB-2011-0091 - Motion by the School Energy Coalition Pursuant to Rule 42 of the Ontario Energy Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure

We are counsel to Ontario Power Generation Inc. ("OPG") in the above-noted matters and are writing in response to the Ontario Energy Board's (the "Board") Notice of Hearing and Procedural Order No. 1.

We have had the opportunity to review the letter filed by the School Energy Coalition pertaining to the timing of submissions by Board Staff, OPG and intervenors on the motions to vary brought by OPG and SEC (collectively, the "Motions"). OPG is substantially in agreement with SEC's comments.

In our respectful submission, the fair and efficient hearing of the Motions on June 2 and 3, 2011 would be enhanced if the moving parties were afforded the opportunity to reply to the submissions of Board Staff and other responding parties. We also agree that responding parties should have the opportunity to review all of the moving parties' materials (including full facts) before having to respond. While accommodating this opportunity will include an additional procedural step, we believe there is adequate flexibility in the existing schedule to preserve the present hearing dates.

We propose the following schedule for the Board's consideration.

1.	Submissions by OPG and SEC in support of their motions	May 6, 2011
2.	Submissions by Board Staff and Intervenors in Response to OPG's motion	May 13, 2011

3.	Submissions by Board Staff, Intervenors and OPG to SEC's motion	May 13, 2011
4.	Reply by OPG to submissions in response to OPG's motion	May 20, 2011
5.	Reply by SEC to submissions in respect of its motion	May 20, 2011
