DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS

Enersource Mississauga Inc. ("Enersource"), a licensed distributor of electricity, filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 15, 2010 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Enersource charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2011. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2010-0078.

The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied and was granted cost award eligibility in this proceeding in relation to Enersource's request for a lost revenue adjustment mechanism recovery.

The Board issued its Decision and Order on the application on March 17, 2011, in which it set out the process for VECC to file its cost claims and to respond to any objections raised by Enersource.

On March 31, 2011, the Board received VECC's cost claim. No comments were received from Enersource.

The Board has reviewed VECC's cost claim and finds that VECC is eligible for 100% of its reasonably incurred costs of participating in this proceeding. The Board finds that VECC's claim is reasonable and Enersource shall reimburse VECC for its costs.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enersource shall immediately pay the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition the sum of \$1,715.01.
2. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Enersource shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
