The Independent Electricity System Operator ("IESO") requests late intervenor status in the above-noted proceeding pursuant to Rule 23.05 of the Board's *Rules of Practice and Procedure*. The IESO has an interest in this proceeding because of its responsibilities as the designated Smart Metering Entity ("SME").
