BACKGROUND

COLLUS Power Corporation (“COLLUS”) filed an application dated March 15, 2011 with the Ontario Energy Board for a licence amendment granting an extension in relation to the mandated date for the implementation of Time-of-Use (“TOU”) pricing rates for Regulated Price Plan consumers.

COLLUS has applied for an extension to its June 2011 mandated TOU date and has requested a new date of December 2011. COLLUS states the reasons for the extension are an unexpected loss of key human resource personnel in charge of the customer information system and implementing TOU pricing.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on March 28, 2011. Board staff filed interrogatories on the application on April 14, 2011. COLLUS responded to these interrogatories on April 26, 2011.

This submission is being provided by Board staff following a review of the application and evidence filed in this proceeding.

STAFF SUBMISSION

Having reviewed the application and evidence, Board staff has no issue with COLLUS's request.
