I address this to the Board on the Application for Leave to Construct Transmission Facilities for Grand Renewable Wind LP.

I noticed that the applicant has stated that the 230,000 volt overhead power line is to run on the North side of Haldimand Rd.#20. On the north side, there are two counties North Cayuga and Onieda. and on the south side Rainham. In the application to construct the overhead 230,000 volt line it will leave the Solar and Windmill Farm at North Cayuga, then run west on the north side of Haldimand Rd.#20 to the landowner A (Parcel 1) seeing this property (1138 is on the south side of the road) in Rainham, this would mean the 230,000 volt overhead line must cross the road to get to this Transition Station at Parcel 1. Then run underground cross #3 highway to get to Landowner B (Parcel 2) Rainham on the south of the road the next Transition Station. Then the 230,000 volt overhead line, it must again cross Haldimand Rd.#20 as the final Land owner C (parcel3) in on the north side of Haldimand Rd.#20 Onieda.

Has anyone noticed that this Hamlet of Nelles have businesses close to the roadway,,, John Deere , Armstrong Seed also a road of residential homes behind. On the north side of Haldimand Rd.#20 a Gas station, Feed lot Armstrong Seed and John Deere property and other businesses. This is a very small area and not a lot of area or straight line for a buried 230,000 line 700 meters long.

Furthermore, I have read that the Wind Developer should assume all Liability for accidents, injuries and deaths during Construction and Operation of their Wind and Solar Farm.

I feel that this Overhead line is 'Way' to close to the roadway, about a car length from the edge of the gravel shoulder to the steel posts.
