UNDERTAKING NO. J4.2: TO REPORT AS TO WHETHER OPA CONTINUED WITH THE FOUR PROGRAMS SET OUT IN MINISTERIAL DIRECTIVE.

RESPONSE

The programs set out in the February 10, 2006 Ministerial Directive are:

- 20/20 The Way to Clean Air
- Diversity Outreach Initiative
- TRCA Greening Health Care
- EcoSchools

The OPA is not directly involved in the funding of these four programs.

The directive requires the OPA “to assume, effective as of the date of this letter of direction, responsibility for seeking up to 300 MW of demand side management and/or demand response initiatives in the Toronto area by 2010.” The directive further requires the OPA to “work co-operatively with Toronto Hydro and the community in the Toronto area in order to avoid duplication of initiatives prior to that date”.

In response to the Ministerial Directive, the OPA entered into contracts with BOMA, the City of Toronto, and Toronto Hydro to procure demand reduction in Toronto. These three parties delivered a variety of energy efficiency programs to consumers in Toronto.
