Re: EB-2010-0039 – Declaratory Order in Respect of Deferral Account No. 179-121 and 179-122 – Comments on Cost Claims

Union has received cost claims from the Canadian Manufacturers and Exporters ("CME"), the Consumers Council of Canada ("CCC") and the Federation of Rentalhousing Providers of Ontario ("FRPO") in the above noted proceeding.

Union does not have any concerns with the cost claims of CCC or FRPO. Union does, however, have concerns with the cost claim of CME.

The CME cost claim includes approximately \$20K for argument incurred after the April 6th hearing. This amount would be significant in any hearing, but particularly in this hearing when parties had been advised to be prepared to argue orally at the hearing. In addition, upon review of the CME cost claim, it is apparent that close to half the time spent on argument was claimed after the Board deadline of April 15th and after having reviewed the submissions of Board staff, CCC and FRPO. In Union's view, the Board should have regard to this timing in its review of the cost claim.
