Subsequent to issuing its Decision and Order dated March 28, 2011 in this matter, the Board became aware that there was a typographical error in the Tariff of Rates and Charges attached to the Decision and Order. Specifically the effective date of the Rate Rider for Tax Change was inadvertently shown as April 20, 2012 rather than April 30, 2012 for certain rate classes. Pursuant to its powers under Rule 43.02 of the Board's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Board has corrected this error and the revised Tariff Sheet is attached.
