Re: PUC Services Inc. – 159.3 kW Solar Generation Project

PUC Services Inc. (the Applicant) plans to install a 159.3 kW (DC) solar panel generation facility on the roof of a recreational facility owned by Algoma University in the City of Sault Ste. Marie. The facility is expected to be connected to the distribution grid in August 2011.

As an affiliate of a distributor, (PUC Distribution Inc.), the Applicant under section 80 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, is required to give notice of its intent to acquire an interest in generation.

The 159.3 kW solar project has been evaluated by the Ontario Power Authority (OPA) and the application for a contract under the FIT program has been approved by the OPA. The solar project will be the third generation project owned by the Applicant. Its local distribution affiliate does not own any generation facilities.

The Applicant submits that because of the small size of the facility and the fact that it is within the OPA's FIT program, the impact of the project does not adversely affect the development and maintenance of a competitive market.
