### **DECISION AND ORDER**

U. S. Steel Canada Inc. filed an application on November 13, 2007 with the Ontario Energy Board pursuant to section 74 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998 to amend electricity generation licence EG-2005-0509.

The current licensee for electricity generation licence EG-2005-0509 is Stelco Inc. United States Steel Corporation ("U. S. Steel") completed the acquisition of Stelco Inc. on October 31, 2007 and as the result of the acquisition Stelco's name was changed to U. S. Steel Canada Inc. U. S. Steel Canada Inc. is an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of U. S. Steel. The change in ownership of the company and consequent change of name was publicly announced at the time of completion of the acquisition. The applicant requested the name change from Stelco Inc. to U. S. Steel Canada Inc. to reflect the amendment to the name of the company.

I have proceeded to decide the application without a hearing pursuant to section 21(4)(b) of the Act since no other parties are adversely affected in a material way by the outcome of the proceeding, and the applicant has consented to disposing of the application without a hearing.

I find that it is in the public interest to grant the requested amendment to the licence.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

The name on Electricity Generator Licence EG-2005-0509 is amended to be U. S. Steel Canada Inc. The amended licence is attached to this Order.
