RE: Union Gas Limited – Red Lake Project OEB File Nos. EB-2011-0040, EB-2011-0041, EB-2011-0041 Lac Seul First Nation Relationship to Grand Council Treaty 3

As per Procedural Order 3, Lac Seul First Nation provides the following information respecting the relationship between the First Nation and Grand Council Treaty #3.

Lac Seul is a signatory to Treaty 3, by adhesion to the treaty in 1874. Lac Seul band members collectively enjoy unique treaty and Aboriginal rights throughout their traditional territory. In respect of the rights assured by Treaty 3, Lac Seul has a special and direct interest in the exercise and the maintenance of these rights in its traditional territory. The Grand Council is a body that advocates the protection, preservation and enhancement of treaty and Aboriginal rights on behalf of the Treaty 3 signatories. Lac Seul is a member of the Grand Council.

Lac Seul is also in the process of making a claim for reserve lands in the Bruce Lake area, on lands that may be under or near the proposed pipeline. Lac Seul asserts that this reserve should have been set aside for it under the provisions of Treaty 3, but in error, was not. Section 18(1) of the *Indian Act* affirms that reserves are held by the Crown for the use and benefit of the respective bands for which they were set apart. Because Lac Seul is the band that asserts the right to the claimed lands, it has specific interests in this proceeding in addition to those raised by the Grand Council generally on behalf of its members.

We hope that this information is of assistance in clarifying this matter for the Board.
