Response to Procedural Order No. 3

Pursuant to Procedural Order No. 3 and as parties with intervenor status, we wish to submit the following commentary on the document entitled "Argument in Chief of Union Gas Limited" ("ACUGL") filed June 14, 2011 with the Ontario Energy Board ("OEB"), amended copy. We understand routing of the proposed gas pipeline to be within the corridor of the road allowance of Wonderland Road North (ACUGL paragraph no. 9). With respect, we request that the OEB in its final direction to UNION on the subject project require definition of exact location(s), east and/or west side of this corridor. This will facilitate appropriate planning for affected adjacent landowners impacted during construction of the gas pipeline.

In addition, we also submit that there are still outstanding issues, which require OEB definition and management in its final direction to UNION concerning the subject gas pipeline construction project.

1. Drainage

There is no evidence that current construction plans take into account the impact on agricultural, residential and municipal drains that will of necessity

be bridged in this project. Appropriate consideration regarding construction management/techniques should be provided to UNION.

2. Off road allowance temporary land use

The original application by UNION cites the need for temporary land use in specific instances (Schedule 12, page 56 and associated Schedule 14, pages 65-67). Such temporary land use and potential crop and other damages should be directed to be compensated at the level of the most recent GAPLO-UNION landowner gas pipeline agreements.

3. Residential/agricultural injurious affection

Consideration of this impact and appropriate direction as necessary should be provided to UNION.

The foregoing is submitted in the spirit of timely management of the proposed construction project and its impact on the parties concerned, as expected OEB direction and approval is given to UNION for this construction project.
