Re: Capital Power GP Holdings Inc.;

Procedural Order No. 6;

By letter dated June 3, 2011, Capital Power GP Holdings Inc., as general partner of Capital Power L.P. ("Capital Power") requested that the Board amend the procedural schedule set out in Procedural Order No. 6 in a manner that would allow intervenors to know Summerhaven's position on all matters at issue before being required to file their own submissions. The Board has not yet responded to our request in this regard.

Subsequent to June 3rd, the Independent Electricity System Operator requested the applicant and an intervenor (Hydro One) to respond to interrogatories that have to do with an issue that has arisen in this proceeding regarding the possibility of a common point of grid connection for both the Summerhaven and Port Dover Nanticoke Windfarms (the "Common Connection Issue"). These interrogatories were in addition to earlier interrogatories from Board staff on this issue.

Capital Power is concerned that the Board's decision on the Common Connection Issue may adversely affect its Port Dover and Nanticoke Wind Project from both a cost and a development timing perspective. This puts Capital Power in a difficult position given that it is not the applicant in this case, with an applicant's right of reply.

In light of the above-described unusual circumstances and notwithstanding the fact that the current procedural schedule makes no such provision, Capital Power would propose to reply to those submissions of the applicant, Board staff and intervenors that may be adverse to the

interests of Capital Power. We would expect that such submissions could be filed with the Board by Tuesday July 5. This would give Capital Power two business days following the July 1st long weekend to prepare its reply, if any.

We would appreciate the confirmation of the Board that the above-described proposal is acceptable.
