Re: Application by Hydro One Networks Inc. for a Six Month Exemption from the Timelines for the Connection of Micro-Embedded Generators Board File Number EB-2011-0118

The Ontario Energy Board has completed a preliminary review of your application.

Accordingly, the Board has now issued its Notice of Application and Written Hearing relating to your application for a six month exemption from the obligations in Section 6.2.6 and 6.2.7 of the Distribution System Code. The Board has posted the English and French versions of the Notice on its website.

You are directed:

- To arrange immediately for the enclosed French version of the Notice headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario", to be posted on the page on Hydro One's website specifically related to micro-embedded generation requirements by June 29, 2011;

- 3. To arrange immediately for a copy of the application and evidence to be posted on the page on Hydro One's website specifically related to micro-embedded generation requirements by June 29, 2011.
- 4. To immediately have the English version of the Notice published, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Ontario Energy Board", in one issue of the *Globe & Mail* newspaper.
- 5. To immediately have the French version of the Notice published, headed with the Ontario Government logo and the words "Commission de l'énergie de l'Ontario", in one issue of *Le Droit* newspaper.

Please note: Invoices regarding publication are not to be sent to the Board.

- 6. To immediately serve a copy of the Notices through email upon all licensed electricity distributors;
- 7. To immediately serve a copy of the Notice, by e-mail on each micro-embedded generator that has submitted an application to Hydro One to be connected to Hydro One's distribution system and that Hydro One has not, as of the date of the Notice, connected in accordance with the requirements set out in Section 6.2.6 and 6.2.7 of the Distribution System Code ("DSC"). Please note this does not apply to the following:
 - a. micro-embedded generators that Hydro One has connected;
 - b. micro-embedded generators that were refused connection prior to the date of Notice;
 - c. micro-embedded generators that have withdrawn their application with Hydro One;
 - d. micro-embedded generators that have allowed their offers to connect from Hydro One to expire.

If e-mail is not available, the Notice should be served by registered mail or by courier to the last known address on record with Hydro One.

8. To provide a copy of the Notice and a cover letter (the "Cover Letter") as described below, by email to each micro-embedded generator that applies to connect to Hydro One's distribution system after Hydro One has fulfilled the all of the requirements of this Letter of Direction, but prior to a Decision and Order being issued by the Board in this matter. If e-mail is not available, the Notice should be served by registered mail or by courier to the last known address on record with Hydro One.

The Cover Letter shall be on Hydro One letterhead and shall read as follows:

The Ontario Energy Board ("Board") has commenced a hearing as described in the attached Notice. Hydro One published and served the Notice in accordance with the Board's directions on *{Hydro One to insert the date on which it fulfilled all requirements of the Letter of Direction dated June XX, 2011}.* As such, this hearing is well underway.
