The purpose of this letter is to request that Intervenor status be granted to myself for the application pursuant to rule 23 of the Boards Rules of Practice and Procedure.

We are concerned that the placement of these overhead 230,000 volt lines will greatly impact the reliability of the service to the Hydro One Grid. We are concerned about vehicle traffic safety on this busy paved roadway, eg. leaving the roadway and striking one of the 100+ steel poles to be constructed on the ROW . This is very likely to occur in the next 25 years on this 19 kilometer long installation, until they are decommissioned. We are concerned about the safety of animals and people because if a 230,000 Volt overhead bare power line was to fall on a vehicle, house or barn steel roofs or Hydro installations either where they run parallel to the roadway or cross the road at so many intersections, the outcome could be beyond our greatest fears. A blow out on the lines with regard to swing of the overhead power lines falling to the roadway. Who is responsible for allowing such an installation to be erected in such a manner? in the Right of Way?

There are gravel roadways that run to Hydro One Grid with 12 less cross roads and much less Haldimand Hydro Power lines and according to Haldimand Roads Department and the Engineering Dept. still a 20 m (66') . the gravel roads are no longer in length. Then there would no need to cross the Provincial Road #3 or set up two transition stations next to such well traveled roadways, and in an area where there are a lot of businesses in the Hamlet of Nelles Corners and Cayuga 5/8 Oval racetrack. I respectfully ask Samsung to look at these other roadways as a safer alternative plan.
