As I am presently within days of completing my electrical work for my project, and will in fact be requesting connection very shortly, does this mean that Hydro One will no longer have to connect my project within the present 5 day guidlines after notice and all approvals are provided to them?

If that is the meaning behind that paragraph, then I do wish to apply for "immediate relief" from their proposed submission so that my project will not unnessesssarily be delayed while this matter is pending the results from their requested hearing. I have been working on this project for the last 6 months.
