1.1.2 Other Parties to the Transaction or Project

On June 14, 2011, SKW LP filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") pursuant to section 92 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the "Act" or "OEB Act") for leave to construct transmission facilities in Chatham-Kent (EB-2011-0217). The proposed transmission facilities are required to connect a 270-MW wind farm (the "Wind Farm") located within the Municipality of Chatham-Kent to the IESO controlled grid. The Wind Farm is being developed pursuant to a Green Energy Investment Agreement between the Government of Ontario and Samsung C&T Corporation and Korea Electric Power Corporation (collectively referred to as the "Korean Consortium").

SKW LP is in the process of applying to the Board for an electricity generator licence. Because SKW LP will be a generator that is acquiring an interest in transmission facilities, it is filing this Notice of Proposal pursuant to Section 81 of the Act.

SKW LP is developing the proposed transmission connection facilities (i.e. it is not purchasing them from another party). As such, there are no other parties to the project.

will not be a dispatchable facility. Therefore, SKW LP will not be able to make use of its status as a transmitter to engage in anti-competitive behaviour in regard to price or timing of the power generated by the Wind Farm.

As described in section 1.1.2 above, the Wind Farm is being developed pursuant to a Green Energy Investment Agreement between the Government of Ontario and the Korean Consortium. The Wind Farm will further the Ontario Government's policy objective to increase the amount of renewable energy generation being added to the province's energy supply mix. In particular, the Wind Farm will contribute a total of 270 MW of clean, renewable energy to the provincial electricity grid.


As SKW LP is filing a Notice of Proposal under section 81 of the OEB Act, it has not provided the information requested in Part II.
