Our Client: Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited ("THESL")


In Procedural Order No. 1 the Board required CANDAS to provide responses to the interrogatories filed by Board Staff and intervenors by Tuesday August 16, 2011. This requirement has not been met. While THESL received its interrogatory responses on August 17, and other responses were filed over the course of last week (Energy Probe responses were only filed yesterday, August 22) some interrogatory responses have still not been filed (VECC).

THESL intends to file evidence, including expert reports, in this proceeding. However, our client and external consultants should be allowed to review and consider the interrogatory responses made by CANDAS to all parties prior to concluding their evidence for THESL.

Accordingly, in view of the delays described above, THESL requests a change in the filing date for Intervenor and Board Staff evidence from August 30, 2011 to two weeks after the last interrogatory responses have been filed by CANDAS.
