Re: Canadian Distributed Antenna Systems Coalitions ("CANDAS") Application OEB File No.:EB-2011-0120 Our Client: Canadian Electricity Association ("CEA")

In Procedural Order No. 1 the Board required CANDAS to provide responses to the interrogatories filed by Board Staff and intervenors by Tuesday August 16, 2011. This requirement has not been met. CEA, among other Intervenors, received late responses to Interrogatories and some interrogatory responses have still not been filed (see, for example, VECC). CANDAS failed to file its response to CEA's interrogatories until August 19, 2011.

CEA concurs with the position of THESL, as set out in its letter to the Board of August 23, 2011, that in view of the delays described above, CEA and its its experts should be permitted to review and consider the interrogatory responses made by CANDAS to all parties prior to concluding their evidence. The number of interrogatories and the resulting responses further justify a change in the filing date for Intervenor and Board staff evidence, in order that the parties may have an opportunity to adequately analyse all of the replies to interrogatories filed by CANDAS.

Accordingly, in view of the delays described above, CEA requests a change in the filing date for Intervenor and Board Staff evidence from August 30, 2011 to two weeks after the last interrogatory responses have been filed by CANDAS.
