Re: Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc.

Notification to the Board as per Decision and Order EB-2007-0099

Service Area Amendment

On March 20, 2007, Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc. filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board under section 74 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 to amend its licensed service area in Schedule 1 of its electricity distribution licence (ED-2002-0574).

This service area amendment was required in order for Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc. to supply electricity to, and receive electricity from, certain portions of Delft Blue Veal Inc.'s ("Delft") land as these certain portions of land are currently located within Hydro One Network Inc.'s licensed service area. These lands were described as the North Half of Lot 12, Conc.9, City of Hamilton, #2120 10th Concession West.

In the Board's Decision and Order (EB-2007-0099) dated July 19, 2007, the service area amendment was granted on the condition that Delft enters into a standard offer program contract with the Ontario Power Authority ("OPA"). Once Delft enters into a standard offer program contract with the OPA, then the service area amendment will be granted, and will become effective 90 days after the execution of the standard offer program contract.

In the above mentioned Decision and Order, Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc. was ordered to notify the Board once the OPA and Delft entered into a standard offer program contract.

On November 16, 2010 Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc. sent a letter to the Ontario Energy Board notifying the Board that the OPA and Delft had entered into a contract on April 9, 2010 under the Feed-in-Tariff ("FIT") Program, (FIT replaces the standard offer program previously offered by the OPA), and requesting the Board to amend and issue its amended licence. The OPA deemed that Delft has a Commercial Operation Date of September 15, 2010. The letter was never received by the Board and no action to amend the licence has been taken.

Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro Inc. is therefore requesting that the Board amend and issue its amended licence.
