Re: Plateau Wind Inc. - Application for an Electricity Generation Licence (Feed-in Tariff Program)

We are counsel to Plateau Wind Inc. ("Plateau"), which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of International Power Canada, Inc. ("IPC"). Plateau is hereby applying to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") pursuant to Section 60 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998* (the "OEB Act") for an Electricity Generation Licence under Section 57(c) of the OEB Act.

Plateau is seeking an electricity generation licence in respect of two generation facilities: (1) Plateau I & II Wind Farm, and (2) Plateau III Wind Farm. Although Plateau requests a single licence covering both of these facilities, because the application form does not support applications for multiple facilities we have enclosed two separate application forms. Also enclosed is payment of the application fee of \$1000.00.

There are two important aspects of this application that we wish to bring to your attention. These relate to the nature of Plateau as the applicant and an urgent request for the expedited processing of this application.

1. Plateau as the Applicant

You will note that, while the applicant for purposes of this application is Plateau, the contracts that have been entered into with the Ontario Power Authority ("OPA") under the Feed-in Tariff ("FIT") Program in respect of each of these projects (the "FIT Contracts") have been entered into between the OPA and IPC. The OPA has also issued Notice to Proceed for each of these projects to IPC, copies of which are attached to the enclosed applications. We recognize the Board's expectation that the licence applicant should be the same person as the holder of the FIT Contracts.

As of September 16, 2011, Plateau, IPC and a subsidiary of IPC have executed all of the reorganization documents to effect the transfer of the assets related to the Plateau I & II Wind Farm and the Plateau III Wind Farm from IPC to Plateau. These assets include the FIT

Contracts. Pursuant to Section 15.5(c) of the FIT Contracts, IPC is permitted to assign the FIT Contracts to an affiliate that is acquiring the facilities without the consent of the OPA, provided that no such assignment shall be valid or effective unless and until such affiliate agrees with the OPA in writing to assume all of IPC's obligations under and be bound by the terms of the respective FIT Contracts. IPC has notified the OPA with respect to the internal transaction and its assignment of the FIT Contracts to Plateau, which is an affiliate of IPC. Plateau has provided to the OPA an executed copy of the OPA's standard form of Assumption and Acknowledgment Agreement. Receipt of the fully executed Assumption and Acknowledgment Agreement from the OPA is pending, but is expected within approximately two weeks of the date of this Application.

Based on the foregoing, and in light of the scheduling constraints described below, we request that the Board process this application without delay on the basis that a fully executed Assumption and Acknowledgment Agreement with the OPA is in place. Plateau will provide confirmation to the Board promptly upon receiving such executed agreement. Alternatively, Plateau would not object if the Board finds it necessary to impose as a condition of licence that an Assumption and Acknowledgment Agreement be entered into with the OPA in respect of the FIT Contracts for each of the Plateau I & II Wind Farm and the Plateau III Wind Farm prior to the commissioning of these facilities.


2. Need for Expedited Processing of this Application

Hydro One Networks Inc. has recently advised Plateau that it must carry out various commissioning and testing procedures in respect of the Plateau III Wind Farm and that the window for performing such commissioning and testing, for which an outage must be scheduled, is in mid-October, 2011. Hydro One further advised that these commissioning and testing procedures require the Plateau III Wind Farm to generate electricity, which will then be conveyed onto Hydro One's distribution system. Accordingly, it is Plateau's understanding that a generator licence must be in place prior to mid-October, 2011 in order to allow for this commissioning and testing to be carried out. If the commissioning and testing cannot be carried out at such time, Plateau has been advised that the next opportunity for Hydro One to schedule an outage and perform the requisite commissioning and testing will be approximately two months later, which would cause significant delays for the project and result in Plateau not achieving its expected commercial operation date.

It is Plateau's understanding that the Board normally processes electricity generation licence applications for FIT-contracted facilities within 30-60 days. We therefore request that this application be processed on an expedited basis so as to allow for the Hydro One testing procedures to be carried out in mid-October, 2011.
