Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("EGD")
ARC Exemption Extension Application

I am writing on behalf of Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters ("CME"). Please consider this correspondence as CME's written comments on EGD's request for various exemptions from Section 2.2.4 of the *Affiliate Relationships Code for Gas Utilities* ("ARC").

In its response to CME IR #1, EGD confirmed there have been no changes to the way Gazifère uses EnMar since EB-2008-0275. Furthermore, in response to CME IR #2, EGD confirmed that in accordance with the ARC, EGD charges Gazifère a monthly services fee for use of the EnMar application. That services fee enables EGD to recover a portion of its operations and maintenance expenses related to hosting EnMar for Gazifère (including software maintenance costs, application support and hosting) determined by the number of meters managed as a percentage.

On the basis of these answers, CME does not oppose the relief that EGD seeks.
