

Dear Ms. K. Walli, Board Secretary,

This letter is in response to the application Plateau- Wind Inc. for an Electricity Generation License File # EB- 2011-0346.

The applicant "Plateau Wind Inc. "I.P.C.-G D.F. (gas de France) - Suez has had ample time to apply for an electricity generation license, under the sole name of "Plateau Wind Inc". F.I.T. contract date (I.P.C.-April19, 2010). The processing of this contract should not be expediated.

Plateau 1,11 and 111 projects were originally called Maxwell, Hatherton and Shrigley. (I.P.C.).

What benefit (reason) does I.P.C. (G.D.F.-Suez) have to transfer the documentation- assets of these projects to Plateau Wind Inc.? This is time con-suming and costly!

One correction that should be noted on the Application under the section -Generation Facilities is:

Plateau Wind Farm should be noted as bounded to the East by SRd. 42.(30)

I.P.C. has (had) ownership of other Industrial Wind Projects eg. Clear Creek (Norfolk), Harrow, Silcote Corners.

To our understanding Suez presently maintains ownership of a large portion of I.P.C. Suez is considered to be the second largest water-processing conglomerate world-wide. G.D.F. (gas de France) is partially owned by the French government.

These are not small Canadian-owned companies!

We urge you to very carefully consider all aspects of this application, before expediating or granting it.
