## ECMI comments on Revised Proposed Amendments to the Affiliate Relationships Code for Electricity Distributors and Transmitters Board File No: EB-2007-0662

1. GENERAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS, Section 1.1 Purpose of the Code

b) preventing a utility from cross-subsidizing affiliate activities;

The proposed changes to 1.1 b appear to create confusion. ECMI suggests that the following wording be considered as it may be clearer with the apparent intent of the draft Code.

b) "preventing a utility from cross subsidizing NON-CONTRACTED activities OF an affiliate";

Further, ECMI has included the draft Code word "preventing" in this definition because ECMI assumes that the authors of the draft Code have rejected ECMI's earlier submission on the absolute standards that the word "preventing" creates. (See ECMI submission date October 25, 2007).
