Grimsby Power Incorporated (Grimsby Power) received interrogatories as follows:

- Board Staff Interrogatories on October 4, 2011
- Energy Probe Interrogatories (EP) on October 5, 2011
- Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition (VECC) on October 7, 2011
- School Energy Coalition (SEC) on October 7, 2011

Grimsby Power has been working diligently on its responses to the Interrogatories and is fully aware of the criticality of maintaining the timeline set by the Board in order to maintain Grimsby Power's request for January 1, 2012 rates. The Interrogatories involve a number of direct questions and the creation of new evidence as follows:

- Re-calculating models with different determinants
- Updated Cost Allocation Model – Board Staff IR # 31
- Filing LRAM evidence not available at the time of the rate submission – Board Staff IR # 38
- Smart Meter Model – Board Staff IR # 42
- Revenue Requirement Work Form - Board Staff IR # 48
- Models for the disposition of Account 1562 – Board Staff IR # 56
- Calculating 2011 financials in MIFRS format – Board Staff IR # 57

The re-calculating of models requires time to make sure they are complete and working the way they were intended. Populating new models requires understanding the models and making appropriate judgments about how to populate them. These processes are extensive and complex. In order for Grimsby Power to provide the best information possible, additional time to complete the Interrogatory process is required.

Grimsby Power is therefore, advising the Board that it will not be filing responses to the Interrogatories by the deadline of October 26, 2011 as required by Procedural Order No. 1. At this time Grimsby Power estimates that it will be in a position to file the Interrogatories by November 9, 2011.

Grimsby Power regrets any inconvenience to the Board as a result of this delay.
