**IN THE MATTER OF** the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

**AND IN THE MATTER OF** an Application by Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. for an Order pursuant to Section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998,* granting leave to construct a natural gas pipeline from Cookstown to Alliston, all in Simcoe County.

## **PROCEDURAL ORDER NO. 1**

Enbridge Gas Distribution Inc. ("Enbridge") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 29, 2011, under section 90 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, Schedule B, (the "Act") for an order granting leave to construct approximately 9.0 kilometres of 203 millimeter diameter (Nominal Pipe Size 8 inch) extra high pressure steel pipeline (the "Pipeline") to reinforce the existing natural gas delivery system in the Alliston Ontario area. The Board has assigned the application file number EB-2011-0323.

The proposed pipeline route begins at Enbridge's Cookstown Gate Station located at 4174 15th Line (also called Victoria Street) and proceeds west along the road allowance of 15th Line for approximately 950 metres to Dufferin Street. The Pipeline then proceeds north along Dufferin Street for 230 metres to Highway 89. The Pipeline then follows Highway 89 westwards for 7.6 kilometres to terminate in the vicinity of Highway 89 and Sideroad 10.

The Board issued a Notice of Application ("Notice") dated October 13, 2011. Enbridge served the Notice as directed by the Board. No party has requested intervenor or observer status in this proceeding and no person has filed a letter of comment.

At this time the Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters. Please be aware that this procedural order may be amended, and further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

## THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Board staff may request information and material from Enbridge that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to Enbridge on or before Friday, November 25, 2011.
- 2. Enbridge shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories no later than **Wednesday**, **December 14**, **2011**.
- Board Staff may make a written submission on the application and file such submission with the Board, and deliver it to Enbridge by Friday, December 23, 2011.
- 4. Enbridge may reply to any submissions by filing a reply submission with the Board on or before **Wednesday**, **January 11**, **2012**.

All filings to the Board must quote file number **EB-2011-0323**, be made through the Board's web portal at <u>www.errr.ontarioenergyboard.ca</u>, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address, telephone number, fax number and e-mail address.

If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the <u>BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca</u>.
