

IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by West Coast Huron Energy Inc. for an order approving the recovery of cost caused by tornado damage to be effective October 1, 2011.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 2

West Coast Huron Energy Inc. ("West Coast Huron or the "Applicant") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on September 8, 2011 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). West Coast Huron is seeking approval to recover the costs caused by an F3 Tornado that occurred on August 21, 2011. The Applicant has requested that the proposed rates be effective October 1, 2011 and remain in effect for a period of 63 months. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2011-0335.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on September 22, 2011.

On October 17, 2011, the Board issued Procedural Order No. 1 which among other things granted Schools Energy Coalition ("SEC"), Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC"), and Association of Major Power Consumers in Ontario ("AMPCO") intervenor status, as requested by each party. The Board also determined that each intervenor was eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*. The Board also declared West Coast Huron's current Tariff or Rates and Charges interim effective November 1, 2011 and established dates for the filing of interrogatories and responses to those interrogatories. The Board further stated that it expects to proceed by way of written hearing in this matter.

On October 24 and October 26, 2011, Board staff and intervenors respectively, filed interrogatories pursuant to Procedural Order No. 1. On November 10, 2011 West Coast

Huron filed responses to Board staff and intervenor interrogatories.

Following a review of the interrogatory responses, the Board has determined that it will make provisions for written final submissions by Board staff and intervenors. The record will close with a reply submission by West Coast Huron.

Please be advised that further procedural orders may be issued from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Board staff and intervenors, if they wish to do so, shall file a submission with the Board and deliver it to West Coast Huron Energy Inc. no later than **December 5**, **2011**.
- 2. West Coast Huron Energy Inc., if it wishes to do so, shall file a reply submission addressing any issues raised in any submissions filed by Board staff or intervenors no later than **December 12, 2011**.
