## DECISION AND ORDER

Enerpro Systems Corp. filed an application on June 17, 2011 with the Ontario Energy Board under section 60 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 (the "Act") for a unit submetering licence. Additional material to complete the application was filed on August 26, 2011.

The Board's Notice of Application and Written Hearing for a unit sub-metering licence was posted on September 6, 2011. No parties responded to the Notice of Application and Written Hearing.

After considering the application, it has been found to be in the public interest to issue a unit sub-metering licence under Part $V$ of the Act to the applicant. The standard term for a unit sub-metering licence is five years, however this licence will have a term of three years.

The applicant has many years of experience providing sub-metering services in British Columbia and Alberta, but has not yet provided such services in the Ontario market. I find that the evidence in the application supported the granting of a licence, but the financial information provided as part of the application was insufficient to support the standard term of five years. The three year term will give the applicant an opportunity to develop its unit sub-metering business in Ontario and improve its financial position.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The application for a unit sub-metering licence is granted, on such conditions as are contained in the attached licence.
