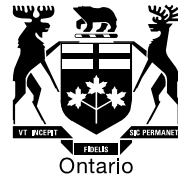

**Re: Greater Sudbury Hydro Inc. ("GSHi")  
2012 Incentive Regulation Mechanism Rate Application  
Board File Number EB-2011-0169  
Notice of Intervention of the School Energy Coalition ("SEC")**

The Board confirms SEC as an intervenor in the above noted proceeding, subject to GSHi's right of reply to your request within 14 calendar days from the filing of your notice of intervention.

The Board has determined that SEC is eligible to apply for an award of costs under its *Practice Direction on Cost Awards* (the "Practice Direction") in relation to GSHi's proposal for lost revenue adjustment mechanism ("LRAM") recovery and request for funding for a renewable generation project through a Smart Grid rate adder.

With respect to the disposition of account 1562, the Board will not consider cost awards as the application is consistent with the various decisions made in the course of the Combined PILS proceeding (EB-2008-0381) including the use of the updated models containing the Excel worksheet 'TAXREC 3' as used by Halton Hills Hydro Inc.
