Further to the Board's Decision and Order dated December 24, 2007 (the "Decision") in this matter and the licenses for Great Lakes Power Limited ("GLPL") and Great Lakes Power Transmission Inc. ("GLPT") on behalf of Great Lakes Power Transmission LP ("GLPTLP") (collectively the "Licenses") annexed to the Decision, this letter is to advise the Board that the description of the applicable transmission systems stated in each Schedule 1 of the Licenses is misstated.

Each Schedule 1 of the Licenses states:

- "51 circuit km of 230 kV line and associated equipment,
- 564 circuit km of 115 kV line and associated equipment, and
- 11 circuit km of 44 kV line and associated equipment which was deemed by the Board as serving a transmission function under Section 84 of the Act."

This description is incorrectly stated and should read:

- "318.25 circuit km of 230 kV line and associated equipment,
- 232.37 circuit km of 115 kV line and associated equipment, and

- 11 circuit km of 44 kV line and associated equipment which was deemed by the Board as serving a transmission function under Section 84 of the Act.”

Accordingly, Schedule 1 to the Licenses should be amended to reflect the correct description set out above.

The above amendment is an updating of the description to reflect the change made to the GLPL transmission system pursuant to the Leave to Construct granted to GLPL in RP-2003-0120/EB-2003-0162.

As a result of the forgoing, it is GLPL’s and GLPT’s request that the Board please confirm in writing that the aforementioned amendment to Schedule 1 of the Licenses will replace the description currently contained in Schedule 1 of each of the Licenses on the effective date of each License.

We note that the Licenses become effective on the close of a commercial transaction whereby the transmission system of GLPL is transferred to GLPTLP. The Licenses are not yet effective since the commercial transaction has not yet been completed. This confirmation is needed in order for the closing of the commercial transaction to proceed. Subject to this confirmation, all other matters in respect of the commercial transaction are resolved. Consequently, GLPL’s and GLPT’s request has a degree of urgency. Attention to this matter by the Board at its earliest convenience would be greatly appreciated.
