Re: LEAP Webcasts on Low-Income Electricity Customer Service Rules, and Emergency Financial Assistance Reporting Requirements

Board staff will be conducting a series of LEAP webcasts for electricity distributors, and their social agency partners, to provide training on the new low-income electricity customer service rules. The webcasts will also review the Emergency Financial Assistance program's annual reporting and monthly monitoring requirements.

Low-Income Electricity Customer Service Rules

On October 1, 2011, customer service rules for eligible low-income electricity customers came into effect. The new low-income customer service rules relate to:

- 1. Eligible Low-Income Customer Definition
- 2. Security Deposits
- 3. Under-Billing Adjustments
- 4. Equal Billing and/or Payment Plan Options
- 5. Disconnection Period
- 6. Assistance Information Before Disconnection
- 7. Arrears Payment Agreements
- 8. Use of Load Control Devices (applied to all customers)

Emergency Financial Assistance Reporting Requirements

The annual Emergency Financial Assistance reporting requirements are outlined in Appendix C.2 of the 2011 LEAP Emergency Financial Assistance Program Manual. Electricity distributors and NRG are expected to file their year-end report with the Board by February 28, 2012. Enbridge and Union are expected to file their year-end report no later than 30 days after they receive the final Winter Warmth program report from their United Way agency partner.

Appendix C.3 outlines the monthly monitoring data requirements that social agency partners are expected to track. Distributors are expected to file a copy of the monthly monitoring data provided by their social agency partners, along with their annual year-end report.

The information collected and reported by distributors and their social agency partners enables the Board to measure and evaluate program performance so as to understand how funds have been disbursed, how effective Emergency Financial Assistance has been in assisting lowincome consumers, and whether any changes to the program are needed.
