RE: Application by Canadian Distributed Antenna Systems Coalition ("CANDAS"); Board File No.: EB-2011-0120

We write on behalf of the Canadian Distributed Antenna Systems Coalition ("**CANDAS**") in response to letters from counsel to THESL dated January 19, 2012 and counsel to CCC dated January 20, 2012.

CANDAS echoes the concerns set out in counsel to CCC's letter, particularly with respect to THESL apparently not distinguishing between the various outstanding interrogatories. In particular, CANDAS IR 1(h) provides as follows:

Were any presentations (oral or in writing) made to the THESL Board of Directors in relation to any of the subjects discussed in the THESL Letter, prior to the letter being filed with the Ontario Energy Board ("Board")? If yes, provide particulars of any oral presentations and copies of any written presentations, including, without limitation, power points, notes, memoranda, executive summaries and any similar writing.

It is inconceivable to us how any reasonable search with respect to this narrow issue would uncover "approximately 40,000 records" with an additional "10,000 records" expected to be uncovered. In CANDAS' submission, it should be a fairly straightforward matter to determine what information the THESL Board was given in relation to the THESL Letter.

We would accordingly expect THESL to provide this information forthwith.
