**INTERROGATORY 6:**

**Reference(s):            Decision and Order on Motion, December 9, 2011, p. 9**  
**CANDAS General IRs 5(e)**

“The Board will order THESL to:

- (a) identify the parties (including the TTC and One Zone and any other parties with attachments which facilitate wireless communications) that currently have wireless attachments on THESL’s poles;
- (b) provide THESL’s master agreement with each party;
- (c) identify the price for the wireless attachments (if not covered in b);
- (d) identify the approximate number of attachments for each party; and
- (e) identify whether there are associated wireline attachments for the wireless attachments.”

**RESPONSE:**

a)     The following third parties have attachments on THESL Poles that are known to facilitate wireless communications:

- DAScom
- Cogeco
- TTC

b) In addition to the attachment agreement between THESI and Toronto Hydro Telecom Inc. (now wholly owned by Cogeco) which THESL filed under cover of letter dated December 23, 2011 and with a request for confidential treatment, the only master agreement THESL has with a wireless attacher is that with DAScom

1 (which has already been filed in this proceeding by CANDAS). Otherwise,  
2 historically THESL has accommodated what has been a relatively minor aspect of  
3 its business on the basis of verbal agreements with other parties such as the TTC.  
4 THESL is in the process of formalizing these arrangements in the ordinary course,  
5 and is accordingly working with these attachers to execute written agreements.

7 c) THESL charges the attachers noted in subpart (a) above the following annual  
8 lease prices for pole space:

- 9 • DAScom - \$22.35/pole/year
- 10 • Cogeco - \$50.00/pole/year
- 11 • TTC - \$22.35/pole/year

13 d) THESL's records indicate that the following is the number of attachments for the  
14 attachers noted in subpart (a) above.

- 15 • DAScom - 369
- 16 • Cogeco - 253
- 17 • TTC - 443

19 e) THESL understands that the DAScom and Cogeco wireless attachments have  
20 associated wireline attachments, although as THESL has stated in this proceeding  
21 (at Tab 5.1, Schedule 16, for example), it is not able to tell on the face of wireline  
22 applications which applications are to support wireless. To the best of THESL's  
23 knowledge, the TTC attachments do not have associated wireline attachments.
