NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN **ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE**

Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Ltd.

Innisfil Hydro Distribution Systems Ltd. ("Innisfil") has applied to the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") for permission to increase its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2012 to reflect the recovery of costs for deployed smart meters. The application was filed on December 19, 2011 under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, 6.0, 1986, c.16 (Schedule B), under the Board's Guideline G-2011-0001: Smart Meter Funding and Cost Recovery — Final Disposition.

Delivery charges are one of four regular items on Residential and General Service customers' electricity bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed. If the application is fully approved, the impact on the monthly bill for a Residential customer would be an increase of \$1.26 per month for the next 24 months. The impact on the monthly bill for a General Service customer taxing a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would be an increase of \$4.14 per month for the next 24 months. The proposed changes to the Delivery charges are separate from other potential changes to the electricity bills.
