IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited for an accounting order to establish a deferral account.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING AND PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 1

Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited ("THESL") filed an accounting order application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the "Board") on February 28, 2012 under section 78.1 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). The application seeks approval to establish a deferral account to accumulate the differences between Canadian Generally Accepted Accounting Principles ("CGAAP") and the Generally Accepted Accounting Principles of the United States ("USGAAP"). The Board has assigned the application File No. EB-2012-0079.

THESL notes in the application that its post retirement benefit difference between CGAAP and USGAAP is estimated to be approximately \$30 million as at January 1, 2011. THESL states that given CGAAP is no longer available beyond December 31, 2011, a transition to a different accounting standard is externally imposed on it and is clearly outside of management's control. THESL further states that the establishment of a deferral account to manage USGAAP differences is justified and consistent with the Board's principles governing the transition to a different regulatory accounting standard and will not impact rates for rate payers.

The Board will adopt as intervenors and observers in this proceeding the intervenors and observers from THESL's electricity distribution rate application for the 2012, 2013

and 2014 rate years (EB-2011-0144). A list of the parties of record in that proceeding is attached as Appendix A. Cost eligibility is addressed below.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters. The Board may issue further Procedural Orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- Board staff and intervenors shall file with the Board and deliver to Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited any interrogatories with respect to the application on or before Wednesday March 28, 2012.
- 2. Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited shall file with the Board and deliver to all intervenors any responses to interrogatories filed with it with respect to the application on or before **Tuesday April 10, 2012.**
- 3. Board staff and intervenors who wish to file a written submission on this issue shall file the submission with the Board and deliver it to all other parties to the proceeding on or before **Tuesday May 1, 2012**.
- 4. If THESL wishes to respond to any submissions, it may do so by filing a response with the Board and delivering it to all other parties to the proceeding on or before **Tuesday May 15, 2012**.
- 5. The Board may order costs in this proceeding. Any party that was determined to be eligible for costs in the EB-2011-0144 proceeding shall be eligible for costs in this proceeding. Any party that is not automatically eligible for costs but expects to seek costs in this proceeding shall file a letter with the Board and copy THESL no later than Friday March 23, 2012. The letter shall provide the grounds for the party's eligibility for costs. THESL will have until Friday March 30, 2012 to object to any new cost eligibility request. Requests for cost eligibility and the determination of cost awards will be addressed in accordance with the Board's Practice Direction on Cost Awards. THESL will be ordered to pay costs for this proceeding.

All filings to the Board must quote the file number, EB-2012-0079, be made through the Board's web portal at https://www.errr.ontarioenergyboard.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must

clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Parties must use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at http://www.ontarioenergyboard.ca/OEB/Industry. If the web portal is not available parties may email their documents to the address below. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file 7 paper copies.
