## RE: Application by Canadian Distributed Antenna Systems Coalition ("CANDAS"); Board File No.: EB-2011-0120

We write on behalf of CANDAS to request that the Board suspend the EB-2011-0120 proceeding until May 25, 2012 to allow CANDAS and Toronto Hydro-Electric System Limited ("**THESL**") time to explore the possibility of reaching a bilateral settlement.

If CANDAS and THESL do reach agreement, it would be CANDAS' intention to file such agreement with the Board for review and to withdraw its Application. CANDAS undertakes to advise the Board as soon as possible (and, in any event, no later than May 25<sup>th</sup>) if it appears that there is no prospect of reaching a bilateral settlement. CANDAS will, at that time, request that the Board issue a Procedural Order that establishes a schedule for the balance of the proceeding.

The request set out above was discussed and has been agreed to by the participants in the Settlement Conference held on March 5, 2012, namely, CANDAS, THESL, Consumers Council of Canada, Electricity Distributors Association, Energy Probe Research Foundation, Hydro One Networks Inc. and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition.
