Board File No. EB-2007-0905 Payment Amounts for Ontario Power Generation Inc.'s Prescribed Facilities Pre-filed Evidence Update and Interrogatory Schedule

Energy Probe Research Foundation (Energy Probe) is hereby requesting an adjustment to the schedule for submitting interrogatories to the Applicant in this proceeding due to an extraordinary Pre-filed Evidence Update. The "Update" was distributed just prior to the scheduled date for interrogatories by Mr. Andrew Barrett in his dual capacity as Vice President of Regulatory Affairs and Corporate Strategy.

The material provided goes far beyond the normal update. The pages are colour coded to distinguish between extensive updated evidence and new evidence. It includes changes approved by OPG's Board of Directors over three months ago. As far as developing the content of interrogatories, intervenors are well advised to start from the beginning.

It was less than a month ago, February 26, 2008, that counsel for OPG, Mr. Michael A. Penny, wrote to the Board expressing OPG's view that "the OEB has provided sufficient notice and a reasonable time for parties to prepare." In keeping with Mr. Penny's theme, Energy Probe requests that the Board continue to provide reasonable time by adjusting its schedule to permit interrogatories to be filed not later that April 7, 2008. The adjustment would permit intervenors time to complete the review of this extraordinary "Update" and submit interrogatories reflecting both updated and new evidence.

In requesting the adjustment, Energy Probe wishes to draw the attention of the Board to the tight schedule parties are experiencing. The interrogatories for EB-2007-0050, Hydro One's Bruce to Milton Leave to Construct, another proceeding with complicated evidence, were due March 10th. The interrogatories for EB-2007-0681, Hydro One's 2008 Distribution Rebasing proceeding, in which extensive evidence has been filed, were due March 14th. The interrogatories to OPG follow the Easter weekend.

On a more personal note, Energy Probe's expert counsel has been out of range of the internet and telephone during the time since the "Update" has been distributed, but returns this weekend. For that reason, my name appears on this submission, rather than that of Mr. Faye.
