Notification of Conditional Approval of Connection Proposal

The IESO has had the opportunity to review and assess your updated connection arrangement for the Detour Lake Gold Mine. The IESO has concluded that the proposed connection of a mid-span opener (MSO) in place of an isolating disconnect switch at the point of connection to Hydro One owned equipment, will not result in a material adverse impact on the reliability of the integrated power system.

The IESO does not need the additional disconnect switch to enhance the reliability of the IESO-controlled grid as the disconnect switches installed at Pinard TS will provide the same functionality. The proposal is therefore acceptable to the IESO and the results of the SIA completed for the Detour Lake Gold Mine connecting to Pinard TS remain valid.

EB-2012-0032 - Detour Gold Corporation's Application to Amend Connection Agreement with Hydro One Networks Inc. - Hydro One Networks' Support Letter

Hydro One Network Inc. ("Hydro One") is of the view that it is acceptable that Detour be relieved of its obligation to provide an isolating disconnect switch at the point of interconnection at Pinard TS.

The intended function of the isolating disconnect switch required by Section 1.2.1 is already performed by the nearby line disconnect switch located inside Hydro One's station. In our assessment, relieving Detour of its obligation to provide an isolating disconnect switch at the point of interconnection would have no adverse impact on system reliability, operations or safety.

To maintain a clear physical demarcation point between the customer's facilities and the transmitter's facilities in the absence of a disconnect switch at the point of interconnection, Hydro One would require Detour to install, prior to connection, a mid-span opener at the point of interconnection.

If the Ontario Energy Board approves Detour's application, Hydro One intends to amend our existing connection agreement with Detour with respect to its connection to the transmission system at Pinard TS.
