**IN THE MATTER OF** the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

**AND IN T HE MATT ER OF** an application by Rideau St. Lawrence Distribution Inc. for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective **May 1, 2012**.

## PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 1

Rideau St. Lawrence Distribution Inc. ("RSL") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, received on Feb 7, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, seeking approval for changes to the rates that RSL charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2012. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2011-0274. The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing on February 29, 2012.

#### Intervenors

The School Energy Coalition ("SEC"), and the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") applied for intervenor status and cost eligibility on March 7, 2012. No other requests were received. No objections were received regarding the applications for intervenor status.

The Board has determined that SEC and VECC will be granted intervenor status. The list of intervenors in this proceeding is attached as Appendix A to this Order. The Board has also determined that SEC and VECC are eligible to apply for an award of costs under the Board's *Practice Direction on Cost Awards*.

#### Interim Rates

RSL requested approval of interim rates as of May 1, 2012 due to the date of the Application. The Board will declare RSL's current approved rates interim pending the Board's decision in this Application. This determination is made without prejudice to the Board's decision on the Application, and should not be construed as predictive, in any way whatsoever, of the Board's final determination with regards to the effective date for rates arising from this Application.

# Rural or Remote Electricity Rate Protection

On December 21, 2011, the Board issued a Decision with Reasons and Rate Order (EB-2011-0405) establishing the Rural or Remote Electricity Rate Protection ("RRRP") benefit and charge for 2012. The Board amended the RRRP charge to be collected by the Independent Electricity System Operator from the current \$0.0013 per kWh to \$0.0011 per kWh effective May 1, 2012. RSL shall begin applying the new charge effective May 1, 2012.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters. The Board has decided to make provision at this time for written interrogatories. At this time, the Board will not make a determination on whether the application will proceed as an oral or written hearing. This determination will be made at a later stage of the proceeding.

The Board considers it necessary to make provision for the following procedural matters.

## THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Rideau St. Lawrence Distribution Inc.'s current Board-approved Tariff of Rates and Charges is declared interim effective **May 1, 2012**, with the revision noted in paragraph 2 below with respect to the Rural or Remote Electricity Rate Protection charge.
- 2. Rideau St. Lawrence Distribution Inc. shall apply a Rural or Remote Electricity Rate Protection charge of \$0.0011 per kWh effective **May 1, 2012**.

- 3. Board staff and intervenors who wish information and material from RSL that is in addition to the evidence filed with the Board, and that is relevant to the hearing, shall request it by written interrogatories filed with the Board and delivered to RSL on or before **April 11, 2012.**
- 4. RSL shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors no later than **May 1, 2012**.
