Re: Application for Recovery of Costs Related to Smart Meter Deployment (EB-2012-0187)

In a subsequent internal review of our recently filed Smart Meter Recovery Rate Application to the Ontario Energy Board, it was discovered that a mistake was made in the Application's submission of the Smart Meter Model.

The mistake in the entry of data to the Smart Meter Model is located on Tab 8. Funding Adder Revenues (at cell K 95, Dec-11 2011 Q4 Funding Adder Revenues). The amount of (\$193,071.73) should in fact be a positive number and not a credit.

The result is that the Smart Meter Disposition Rider (SMDR) should calculate to be (\$0.89) and not \$0.67) as reflected in the Application.

Could we request the OEB's guidance's as to the best approach to correcting the Application? My added concern is that the OEB issues a Letter of Notice and Letter of Direction before this correction can be made.

Please, if London Hydro could ask the OEB as to what might be the appropriate approach in correcting this mistake in the Application?
