## RATE ORDER

On October 29, 2007, Canadian Niagara Power Inc. – Fort Erie ("CNPI – Fort Erie") filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board, (the "Board") under section 78 of the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998; S.O. 1998, c.15 Schedule B, for an order or orders approving or fixing just and reasonable rates for the distribution of electricity effective May 1, 2008. The Board assigned file number EB-2007-0839 to the application.

On March 19, 2008, the Board issued its Decision (the "Decision") in the matter of CNPI – Fort Erie's application.

The Board directed CNPI – Fort Erie to file with the Board a Draft Rate Order attaching a proposed Tariff of Rates and Charges reflecting the Board's Decision, within 7 days of the date of the Decision.

In accordance with the Board's direction, CNPI – Fort Erie has provided the Board with a Draft Rate Order and Tariff of Rates and Charges.

In the Decision the Board directed CNPI – Fort Erie to limit the rate increase, if required, to the Street Lighting class to 10% and to include the foregone revenue, if any, in a deferral account. The resultant tariff of rates from the Board's 2008 IRM decision model for CNPI – Fort Erie does not yield a rate increase in excess of 10%, thus mitigation is not required.

The Board is satisfied that the Draft Rate Order and Tariff of Rates and Charges accurately reflects the Decision.

## THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix A of this Rate Order is approved, effective May 1, 2008, for electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after May 1, 2008.
- 2. The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix A of this Order supersedes all previous distribution rate schedules approved by the Ontario Energy Board for CNPI Fort Erie, and is final in all respects.
- 3. CNPI Fort Erie shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than with the first bill reflecting the new rates.
