REVISED RATE ORDER

Introduction

Brant County Power Inc. ("Brant County Power"), a licensed distributor of electricity, filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 28, 2011 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Brant County Power charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2012.

In its Decision and Order on the application issued on March 22, 2012, the Board ordered Brant County Power to review the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges and to file with the Board a written confirmation assessing the completeness and accuracy of the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges, or provide a detailed explanation of any inaccuracies or missing information, within seven calendar days of the date of the Decision and Order.

On April 2, 2012, Brant County Power filed a letter advising the Board that Brant County Power's evidence regarding host distributor transmission charges was not considered. Brant County Power noted that it pays monthly transmission charges to Brantford Power Inc. on three delivery points. Brant County Power further noted that the financial impact as a result of not adjusting the Retail Transmission Service Rates ("RTSRs") would be an annual under recovery of \$607,011. Brant County Power also included in its letter a schedule (the "Schedule") that outlines the proposed RTSRs with the inclusion of the transmission charges payable to Brantford Power Inc. In its calculations, Brant County Power used the Uniform Transmission Rates ("UTRs") effective January 1, 2011.

On April 3, 2012, Brant County Power filed an update to the Schedule that incorporates the UTRs that became effective January 1, 2012.

The Board has reviewed the evidence provided by Brant County Power and accepts Brant County Power's request and has revised the draft Tariff of Rates and Charges. However, the Board notes that for the Sentinel Light rate class the RTSR – Network charge should be \$1.5161 per kW and the RTSR – Line and Transformation Connection charge should be \$1.0323 per kW.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT

 The Tariff of Rates and Charges set out in Appendix A of this Order will become final effective May 1, 2012, and will apply to electricity consumed or estimated to have been consumed on and after May 1, 2012. Brant County Power shall notify its customers of the rate changes no later than with the first bill reflecting the new rates.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICE CLASSIFICATION

This classification applies to an account taking electricity at 750 volts or less where the electricity is used exclusively in a separate metered living accommodation. Customers shall be residing in single-dwelling units that consist of a detached house or one unit of a semi-detached, duplex, triplex or quadruplex house, with a residential zoning. Separately metered dwellings within a town house complex or apartment building also qualify as residential customers. All customers are single-phase. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

APPLICATION

The application of these rates and charges shall be in accordance with the Licence of the Distributor and any Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, which may be applicable to the administration of this schedule.

No rates and charges for the distribution of electricity and charges to meet the costs of any work or service done or furnished for the purpose of the distribution of electricity shall be made except as permitted by this schedule, unless required by the Distributor's Licence or a Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, or as specified herein.

Unless specifically noted, this schedule does not contain any charges for the electricity commodity, be it under the Regulated Price Plan, a contract with a retailer or the wholesale market price, as applicable.

It should be noted that this schedule does not list any charges, assessments or credits that are required by law to be invoiced by a distributor and that are not subject to Board approval, such as the Debt Retirement Charge, the Global Adjustment, the Ontario Clean Energy Benefit and the HST.

Such connections include cable TV power packs, bus shelters, telephone booths, traffic lights, railway crossings, etc. The level of the consumption will be agreed to by the distributor and the customer, based on detailed manufacturer information/ documentation with regard to electrical consumption of the unmetered load or periodic monitoring of actual consumption. Further servicing details are available in the distributor's Conditions of Service.

The application of these rates and charges shall be in accordance with the Licence of the Distributor and any Code or Order of the Board, and amendments thereto as approved by the Board, which may be applicable to the administration of this schedule.
