DECISION AND ORDER ON COST AWARDS May 4, 2012

Background

Orangeville Hydro Limited ("Orangeville Hydro"), a licensed distributor of electricity, filed an application with the Ontario Energy Board (the "Board") on October 14, 2011 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B), seeking approval for changes to the rates that Orangeville Hydro charges for electricity distribution, to be effective May 1, 2012. The Board assigned the application file number EB-2011-0190.

The Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition ("VECC") was granted intervenor status and cost award eligibility in regards to Orangeville Hydro's request for lost revenue adjustment mechanism recovery and any revenue-to-cost ratio adjustment matters that go beyond implementation of previous Board decisions.

The Board issued its Decision and Order on the application on March 22, 2012, in which it set out the process for VECC to file its cost claims and to respond to any objections raised by Orangeville Hydro.

On April 10, 2012, the Board issued a corrected Rate Order.

VECC's cost claim was received by the Board on April 12, 2012. No comments were received from Orangeville Hydro.

The Board has reviewed VECC's cost claim and finds that VECC is eligible for 100% of its reasonably incurred costs of participating in this proceeding. The Board finds that VECC's claim is reasonable and Orangeville Hydro shall reimburse VECC for its costs.

THE BOARD THEREFORE ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Orangeville Hydro shall immediately pay the Vulnerable Energy Consumers Coalition the sum of \$1,421.38.
- 2. Pursuant to section 30 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, Orangeville Hydro shall pay the Board's costs of and incidental to, this proceeding immediately upon receipt of the Board's invoice.
