Residential consumers on Time-Of-Use (TOU) Pricing will pay 6.5 cents per kilowatt hour during off-peak hours, 10 cents per kilowatt hour during mid-peak hours, and 11.7 cents per kilowatt hour during on-peak hours. NOTE: Prices will be reviewed by the OEB and may be adjusted every six months.
