
**I, Scott Joseph Miller, of the Town of Caledon, MAKE OATH AND SAY AS



## Electricity Rates

Your electricity bill from Hydro One Brampton will include changes to the delivery and energy components of your bill. These changes have been approved by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB).

The OEB, responsible for regulating the distribution rates of utilities across the Province, has given approval to Hydro One Brampton Networks Inc. ("Hydro One Brampton") for an adjustment to our rates and charges. These changes will affect the **"Delivery"** line of all customer bills, effective May 1, 2012.

Hydro One Brampton had been previously given approval for an adjustment to its electricity distribution rates, effective January 1, 2012. In addition, on April 19, 2012, the OEB announced an adjustment to Regulated Price Plan electricity commodity prices that take effect on May 1, 2012.

## Residential Electricity Rates

### For customers on the Regulated Price Plan's [Time-Of-Use Pricing](#)

The Ontario Energy Board recently announced new electricity prices for the summer months, from May 1, 2012 to October 31, 2012. Residential consumers on Time-Of-Use (TOU) Pricing will pay 6.5 cents per kilowatt hour during off-peak hours, 10 cents per kilowatt hour during mid-peak hours, and 11.7 cents per kilowatt hour during on-peak hours. *NOTE: Prices will be reviewed by the OEB and may be adjusted every six months.*
