IN THE MATTER OF the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*, S.O. 1998, c. 15, (Schedule B);

AND IN THE MATTER OF an application by Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation for an order approving just and reasonable rates and other charges for electricity distribution to be effective May 1, 2012.

PROCEDURAL ORDER No. 2 June 1, 2012

Chapleau Public Utilities Corporation ("Chapleau" or the "Applicant") applied to the Ontario Energy Board for permission to increase its delivery charges beginning May 1, 2012. The application was filed on January 30, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, 1998, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B). Further to a letter from the Board issued on February 8, 2012, Chapleau filed additional information on March 16, 2012. The Board has assigned the application File Number EB-2011-0322.

The Board issued a Notice of Application and Hearing dated April 13, 2012. Chapleau submitted its Affidavit of Publication on April 23, 2012, indicating that the Notice was published on April 21, 2012. On May 4, 2012, the Board issued Procedural Oder No. 1 which set dates for interrogatories and interrogatory responses. By way of a letter filed with the Board on May 29, 2012, Chapleau requested an extension of the interrogatory response deadline to June 25, 2012. The Board is interested in proceeding as quickly as possible with this Application and will grant an extension to June 20, 2012.

The Board may issue further procedural orders from time to time.

THE BOARD ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Applicant shall file with the Board complete responses to the interrogatories and deliver them to the intervenors no later than **June 20, 2012**.
- 2. All filings to the Board must quote file number EB-2011-0322, be made through the Board's web portal at www.errr.ontarioenergyboard.ca, and consist of two paper copies and one electronic copy in searchable / unrestricted PDF format. Filings must clearly state the sender's name, postal address and telephone number, fax number and e-mail address. Please use the document naming conventions and document submission standards outlined in the RESS Document Guideline found at www.ontarioenergyboard.ca. If the web portal is not available you may email your document to the BoardSec@ontarioenergyboard.ca. Those who do not have internet access are required to submit all filings on a CD in PDF format, along with two paper copies. Those who do not have computer access are required to file seven paper copies. If you have submitted through the Board's web portal an e-mail is not required."
- 3. All communications should be directed to the attention of the Board Secretary at the address below, and be received no later than 4:45 p.m. on the required date.
