# NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND HEARING FOR AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION RATE CHANGE

PowerStream Inc.

PowerStream Inc. has applied to the Ontario Energy Board for permission to change its delivery charges beginning January 1, 2013. The application was filed on May 4, 2012 under section 78 of the *Ontario Energy Board Act*, *1998*, S.O. 1998, c.15 (Schedule B).

PowerStream Inc. currently has two rate zones, one for the former PowerStream service territory in York Region ("South") and one for the former Barrie Hydro service territory in Barrie and Simcoe County ("Barrie"). In this application, PowerStream seeks to harmonize rates between these two rate zones.

Delivery charges are one of four regular items on Residential and General Service customers' electric bills and vary depending on the amount of electricity consumed. If the application is approved as applied for, the monthly bill for a Residential customer who consumes 800 kWh per month will increase by about \$2.41 in the PowerStream South service area, and decrease by \$3.38 in the PowerStream Barrie service area. The monthly bill for a General Service customer consuming 2,000 kWh per month and having a monthly demand of less than 50 kW would increase by about \$0.79 in the PowerStream South service area and decrease by \$1.94 in the PowerStream Barrie service area separate from other potential changes to the electricity bills, which are not affected by this application.
